Resolving Conflicts at School

Overview from Julie Hirsch, School Psychologist

LHCS has two great ways students can address conflict at Upper Campus: 1. Peer Mediation Communication and 2. The Bully Box.

Peer mediation

Mediation is available to students in grades 5-8. It is the most effective way to resolve differences between individuals and one of the best approaches to conflict resolution in the schools. The process relies on neutral, third parties to help students engaged in a conflict to use communication, negotiation, and problem-solving skills to reach a mutually beneficial agreement.

Eleven 7th and 8th graders were selected and trained to be meiators this year. They were chosen by their teachers and peers because they show good judgment, engender trust and respect, display leadership skills, and communicate well with others.

A teacher, student, or mediator can request mediation by filling out a request form on the Lake Harriet webpage or in the main office, or by contacting Julie Hirsh. All mediations are voluntary and each disputant must agree to follow basic ground rules. The mediations occur during the school day with an effort to minimize loss of academic time.

The Bully Box

The Student Council created the Bully Box for grades 3-8 to report incidents anonymously. It is located in the office, along with reporting forms. All reports are taken seriously. (There is a consequence for any clearly fabricated reports.) An adult will follow-up and talk to the student or students who are bullying.

Students have been given the following definition of bullying: Bullying is when one or more people repeatedly harm, harass, intimidate, or exclude others. Bullying is unfair and one-sided. Bullying includes both direct (e.g., physical aggression, verbal abuse) and indirect (e.g., gossip, nasty looks) forms.
